

# SNOWFLAKE TABLE RUNNER Designed by Jean

Fabric 1 (light color fabric) 1/3 yards

Fabric 2 (dark color fabric) 1-5/8 yards

Fabric 3 (coordinating fabric for snowflakes) fat quarter

Fabric 1	Center Blocks	Cut 3	10-1/2" Sq.
Fabric 2	Setting Triangles	Cut 1	15-1/2" Square
	End Pieces	Cut 2 Cut 2	11" X 4-1/2" 15" X 4-1/2"
	Binding	Cut 3	1-1/2" X WOF
	Backing	Cut 2	17" X WOF

Fabric 2 - Cutting setting triangles – cut the 15-1/2" square of setting triangle fabric twice on diagonal to yield four Quarter Square Triangles.

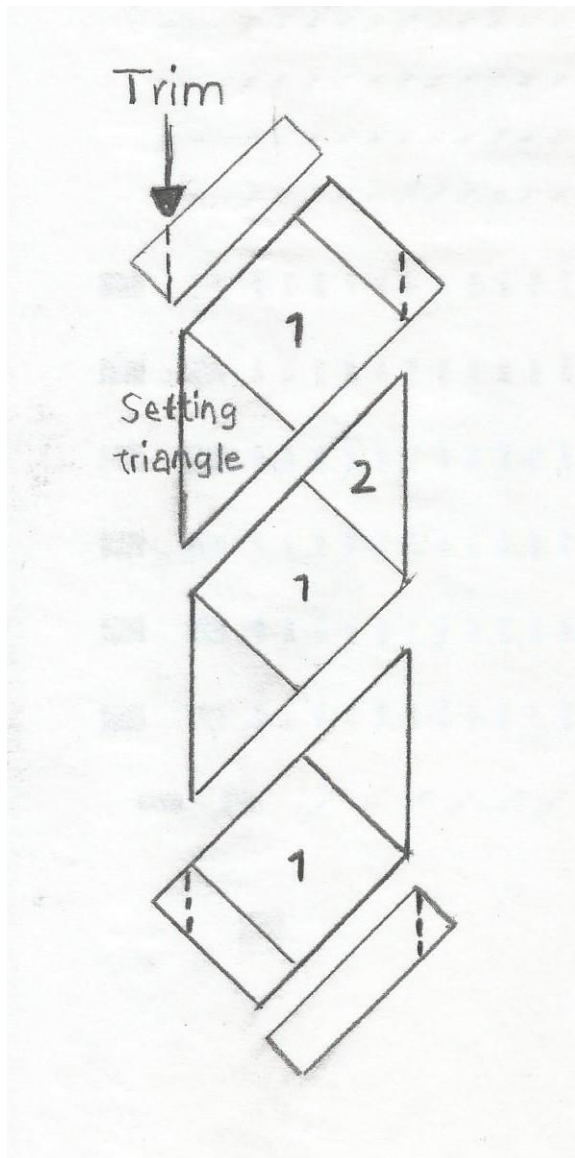
Cut two end pieces 11" X 4-1/2" and two 15" X 4-1/2".

## **Sewing Setting Triangles & End Pieces**

Sew two setting QST's to block in middle of runner. For top block, sew QST setting triangle to bottom and shorter end strip to top edge. For bottom block, sew QST setting triangle to top edge and shorter end piece to bottom edge. Press seams

toward triangles and end strips. Sew the longer end pieces to top and bottom.

Sew the three sets of sub-blocks together in diagonal rows. Press all seams between rows down. Trim end pieces even with the long edges of the runner.



**Fabric 3 - Snowflakes for Center Blocks** – make 3 snowflakes using Wonder Under for the iron-on applique. Center each snowflake onto the center blocks and press in place with steam.

Prepare a backing by sewing the two pieces together to make a pieced backing - approx. 17" X 56". Sandwich, quilt and bind.

Finished size: 53-3/4" X 14-1/2"
